

GENERAL FUNCTION

ARTICLE 1

PURPOSE OF THE REGULATION

The purpose of these rules of the Angelini University Award! 2018/2019 (hereinafter referred to as the "Rules") is to define the terms of participation, overall functioning and evaluation of the Angelini University Award ("AUA! 18/19" or simply the "Competition").

ARTICLE 2

ORGANIZER

The competition is organised by Angelini İlaç San. ve Tic. A.Ş., registered office: Nispetiye Mah. Aytar Cad. Fecri Ebcioğlu Sk. RSD Plaza No:4 Kat:1 34340 Beşiktaş / İstanbul (hereinafter referred to as "Angelini İlaç" or the "Organizer").

ARTICLE 3

PURPOSE OF CONTEST

The competition aims to contribute to the dynamic development of innovation and creative approach in the fields related to health through a project based on the quality and relevance of the jury of the competition and the public.

ARTICLE 4

AWARD WINING RULES

1. The Organizer of the competition reserves the exclusive right to interpret and apply the rules set forth herein and to resolve any issues not dealt with by these rules.
2. The selection criteria and the reasons for the decision, including prize award, are the sole decision-making authority and responsibility of Angelini Company. Under no circumstances, any complaint or appeal against the evaluation of this competition, which is irreversible and definitive, cannot be lodged.
3. Angelini reserves the right not to award a prize if such a step were inconsistent with the applicable rules, or if the jury finds that none of the submitted projects meets the rules of the competition, for example, it does not achieve the required quality.
4. Angelini reserves the right not to award prizes if less than 10 projects sign up for the competition, or less than 10 projects are submitted within the specified deadline.

ARTICLE 5

PROJECT CONTENT

"AUA! 18/19" invites university students to produce projects in areas related to "Health-Supported Ideas". In this context, especially in the fields of Medicine, Pharmacy, Nursing, Social Work, Law, Biomedical Engineering, Informatics Engineering, Economics, Business Administration and Marketing, economic, financial, creative and technological approaches can be considered.

Some suggestions for projects that can be developed under the theme of the contest:

1. Social Responsibility Projects

- a)* Awareness-raising projects on health problems threatening the majority of the society (Obesity, Heart, Diabetes, Celiac, Cholesterol, Hypertension, etc.)
- b)* Educational projects that support good nutrition for those with less economic resources
- c)* Innovative feeding solutions to reduce risk factors
- d)* Innovative projects that can be carried out in cooperation with institutes working in this field
- e)* Non-profit organization projects for disadvantaged communities on nutrition
- f)* Non-profit organization projects for special needs holders
- g)* Non-profit organization projects for prevention of nutritional diseases
- h)* Proper nutrition projects for young people or children
- i)* Turkey and World Hunger: Social Responsibility – Non-profit organization Projects
- j)* Global nutrition policies and projects

2. Projects for Products and Services

- a) Establishing business plans for products in the field of nutrition
- b) Establishing business plans for services in the field of nutrition
- c) Establishment of special supplementary food for risk groups in the field of nutrition
- d) Projects for supplements
- e) The place of nutritional supplements in our life
- f) Research and projects for eating habits
- g) New communication methods on nutrition science
- h) Projects related to nutrition services

PARTICIPANTS

ARTICLE 6

SCHEDULE

1. The Competition will take place from 8 April 2019 to 30 June 2019.
2. The application must be submitted no later than 30 June 2019, 23:59.
3. The deadline for submitting projects is 30 June 2019, 23:59.
4. The final ceremony will take place in October 2019.

ARTICLE 7

AWARDS

1. Prizes are of a monetary nature, a specific amount of money will be rewarded to two of the best projects:
 - a) The first group shall receive 25.000 TL gross (if this complies with the provisions of paragraph 2 of Article 8)
 - b) The second group shall receive 15,000 TL gross (if this complies with the provisions of paragraph 2 of Article 8)
2. The distribution of the awards among the individual team members shall be made equally by Angelini İlaç. Each member of the winning team receives a honorary diploma valuing their work.
3. The winners understand that the prizes are subject to statutory income tax and in accordance with the law, the prizes will be duly taxed by the Organizer of the competition prior to handover,
4. All contestants / Competition Team or authors of the other projects and their individual members receive a diploma valuing their participation in the competition.
5. The entitlement to the award of prizes will automatically and definitively disappear without any further formal procedure, if one of the following situations arises:
 - a) The winning team/teams application contains discrepancies; There are indications that the project concerned has been drawn up by persons other than those indicated in the application;
 - b) If the project has been developed by others not mentioned in the application submitted;
 - c) If the project has been developed by other persons not mentioned in the submitted application;
 - d) If the project has been developed by other persons not mentioned in the application submitted;
 - e) The winner does not apply for the payment of the prize within one year from the date of its award,
 - f) The winner/winners refuse to express unconditional approval of these rules,
 - g) The project topic does not correspond to the given topic or otherwise violates the rules of this competition or morality.
6. Unless otherwise provided by the provisions of these Rules, the allocation of prizes shall not, in addition to obtaining a monetary reward, confer other rights. In this Regulation, awarding of award shall not entitle any other rights except to allocate the related amount.

ARTICLE 8

APPLICATION CONDITIONS

1. Participants in this competition may only be teams consisting of 2 – 5 individuals who are university students within the framework of bachelor's, master's and postgraduate study programs in the academic year 2018/19 at a university in the Turkey, including students studying within exchange programs (hereinafter referred to as "Competition Team", "Participant" or "Contestant").

The Competition Team must select one of their members to act as their representative (hereinafter referred to as "Team Leader").

Each individual member of the Competition Team must be able to prove that he/she is a student of the relevant university by submitting the relevant documents proving the above to the competitor's invitation.

2. The competition projects must meet the following requirements:

- a) Their author must not be a member/members of the jury,
- b) The competition projects fully apply to the rules of this competition and meet the quality requirements of the competition,
- c) Each Competition Team may enter this competition in the academic year 2018/2019 only once,
- d) Each individual member of a team may be a member of only one team or one participant,
- e) Members of the Competition Team may and may not study at the same university or at the same course,
- f) Each team consist of a minimum of two and a maximum of five members,

3. The winning projects can only be awarded once.

ARTICLE 9

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. An application for a competition that complies with provisions of these Rules is (with the consent of all members of the Competition Team) formally submitted by the team leader by filling in the online form at www.aua.com.tr within the time limit set by these rules within the deadline set for submitting applications.

2. As part of filling in the online form, the team leader is required to state:

Identification of the individual team members (name, surname, adress, e-mail, telephone number, university/faculty, year);

A copy of the certificate/student ID card of study at the University of Turkey in the academic year 2018/2019 of all members of the Competition Team

3. Under the Law on the Protection of Personal Data, all members of the group must submit a completed and signed confirmation of the processing of personal data by Angelini Pharmaceutical for all communication

methods and photos considered to be relevant in the context of announcing and disseminating the Angelini University Award.

4. This confirmation document must be scanned digitally and sent to aua.turkey@gmail.com e-mail address in electronic form.
5. By formally submitting the application form (by filling in and sending the web form, including the certificate/student ID card, individual members of the Competition Team provide unconditional consent to the provisions of these Rules, including a consent to the processing of their personal data; at the same time they agree with verification of the accurate and authenticity of the data provided.

ARTICLE 10

PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION OF PROJECT

1. The submitted projects to the competition should meet the following criteria, they must contain:
 - a) The name of the project; the identification of the individual authors (members of the Competition Team) of the project and the educational institution where they belong,
 - b) The project may not exceed 50 pages, should be prepared and sent in PPT, PDF or similar editor
 - c) The projects must be written in Turkish or English
2. The PPT presentation can be supplemented with file attachments (posters, video footage, models, models, MP4 or WMA format videos, product samples, etc.).
3. Projects must be uploaded in www.aua.com.tr web site and/or sent via e-mail to aua.turkey@gmail.com and/or by registered mail in the envelope to the Angelini University Award! 2018/2019, Angelini İlaç San. ve Tic. A.Ş., Nispetiye Mah. Aytar Cad. Fecri Ebcioglu Sk. RSD Plaza No: 4 Floor: 1 34340 Besiktas / Istanbul address.
4. Uploading in web site, sending via e-mail or sending by registered mail must be made within the deadline for submitting projects, no later than 30th June 23:59 on the last day of the deadline. Postal items delivered after this date are not taken into consideration.
5. Once the project has been submitted, a receipt will be sent to the group of participants.
6. The projects submitted during the competition will not be returned to the participants.

ELECTION AND AWARD DELIVERY

ARTICLE 11

CRITERIA FOR THE SELECTION OF COMPETITION FINALISTS

When evaluating projects, the jury will focus on evaluating their benefits based on the following criteria:

- Innovation;
- Creativity;

- Methodologies / Techniques;
- The relevance of the project to the subject;
- Practical feasibility of projects / implementation (including compliance with legal regulations);
- Presentation Format: Format, Content, Presentation and Other Materials (if submitted).

ARTICLE 12

JURY

1. The jury of the competition consist of members experts in areas covering the topic of the competition and one of them shall be appointed as the chairman of the jury.
2. The jury members will be announced when the time comes.
3. In the event that the jury does not feel competent to assess the substance of a project, they may ask one or more experts to cooperate, provided that the majority of its members agrees with it. The contact with the expert/experts is provided by the chairman of the jury or a member of the jury appointed by the chairman of the jury.
4. After all the projects have been submitted; the jury evaluates and selects no more than 10 finalists of this competition.

ARTICLE 13

ANNOUNCEMENT OF AWARDED PROJECTS, AWARDS CEREMONY

1. An announcement of the projects awarded under the AUA! 18/19 competition will rake place during a public event. The venue and date/time will be announced by the Organizer to the participants in advance.
2. Authors (or individual participants) of the 10 projects pre-selected by the jury, will be asked to present their projects within the three-minute presentation at the public event. Then the jury selects no more than 5 best projects. Their authors will publicly present their projects within the seven-minute presentation also within the framework of the event to all participants of the event. At the end of the above presentation, there will be a secret vote on the best project that can be cast by all (invited) AUA! 18/19 participants, which means all participants in the competition being present at the event (with the exception of finalists) as well as other participants. Each registered participant has one vote. The vote will be performed during the event. The winning projects will then be decided by all participants of the AUA! 18/19 with the exception of the members of the 5 final teams.
3. Following the day of the event, Angelini Pharmaceuticals will publish the winners' names on the website.
4. To qualify for the prize, the participants in the competition whose projects were selected as the winning ones by participants in the AUA! 18/19 must meet the following conditions:
 - a) Participate in the aforementioned event (at least 1 member of the Competition Team);
 - b) Allow universities and Angelini İlaç to publish award-winning persons and data in order to promote the competition;
 - c) The individual members of the Competition Team must agree to publish their personal data (name, surname, city, university) and publish their photographs to the extent specified by these Rules: the publish and use the project to extent set forth in these Rules; once the above conditions are met, that participants are entitled to the appropriate prize.
5. The prizes will be handed over to the winning Competition Teams in the framework of the aforementioned public event in the form of "image vouchers" in the hands to any member of the Competition Team. In order to collect the prize, the team must present the voucher and confirm an agreement with the prize collection. The

above agreement must be confirmed in writing by all members of the team. Subsequently, the funds will be reimbursed to the bank account submitted, but no later than one year after the date of the voucher delivery.

ARTICLE 14

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS RELATED TO PROJECTS

The intellectual property rights related to the project belongs to the project authors.

However, individual members of the Competition Team, by their participation in the competition and by signing up for the competition, give the Organizer a non-exclusive free consent allowing the Organizer use the projects and all its components solely for the purpose of organizing, evaluating and promoting the competition, in particular at public events and on www.aua.com.tr website, and for promotional and marketing purposes within the Angelini University Award! promotion, to an unlimited extent (including unlimited territory, quantity, and time). The Organizer is not obliged to use this license and is entitled to modify the projects for their needs in accordance with the Copyright Act, as amended, and to continue to use the modified projects. If for the purposes of the Copyright Act, any necessary further approval of the Participant is required for any further handling of the project (e.g. its modification, processing, translation, the creation of a joint work, etc.); such consent is expressly granted by participating in this competition.

Individual members of the Competition Team explicitly declare that they are the authors/co-authors of the project and are authorized to grant such authorizations. In the event that the competition proves otherwise, the Competition Team member shall be fully responsible for all damages incurred to the Organizer in this respect and shall be obliged to fully pay for the damages forthwith. In particular, this means that if, due to a lack of the above, the Organizer or any other person has suffered any damage (e.g. imposing an obligation to provide satisfaction or to impose a fine) or expenses, the relevant member of the Competition Team is obliged to pay them in full.

ARTICLE 15

FINAL PROVISIONS

The terms and dates set forth in this Regulation may be amended by the decision of Angelini İlaç.
